### Introduction

We understand that Asbestos management in school is a top Health and Safety priority. As part of our ongoing management of this issue the school has taken the following measures.

- 1) Headteacher requested Local Authority to arrange Whole School Asbestos Survey.
- 2) Headteacher and Site Manager attended Asbestos Awareness course.

The school will always presume asbestos to be in the building should any repairs be made to the school. This includes walls, ceilings and flooring. An Asbestos Survey by a qualified company will be made for any repairs to take place until a full survey takes place. The Building/Health and Safety sub-committee of the Governors will oversee that this policy is implemented. The Site Manager will liaise with building contractors and report to the Headteacher.
