Investigative theme: Holidays/

Dear Parents/Carers

Here we are in the final half term of your child's Nursery year!! An exciting time for them but sad for us as we will miss them. They are wonderful children and we have had a great year!!

In the learning areas we will be focusing on;

Communication Language and Literacy/ Reading and Writing,

As usual we will plan around the children's interests and support the children in language skills through rhymes, songs and stories, building on their existing phonetic knowledge to sound out and read simple words. We will encourage the children to use books correctly, to hold the book the right way up and turn pages, to handle them carefully, to be aware of how stories are structured and to know that information can be relayed in the form of print. Thank for returning the reading folders regularly the children are really enjoying this experience. This is a great home/school link as well as helping to develop valuable reading skills.

Maths

The children will be encouraged to use number names and language spontaneously, to show curiosity about numbers by offering comments or asking questions, to use some number names accurately in play, to recognise groups with higher numbers and to match number and quantity correctly. We will be using our topic to think about shape, space and distance.

Understanding of the World,

We will encourage the children to show an interest in the world in which they live, to describe and talk about what they see and to show curiosity about why things happen and how things work. We will support the children in using non fiction books, photographs, the internet and television to gather information about our topic to scaffold and build on their existing knowledge and natural curiosity.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be focusing on encouraging the children to demonstrate flexibility and to adapt their behaviour to new events, social situations and changes in routine. This is a time of change for the Nursery as they are preparing to go into Reception and they are very excited about this. Every Wednesday a group of children will go into Reception for a morning or afternoon session as part of the transition process. The children will start go into the hall for their lunch on Monday 11th July, they can make independent choices about what they eat (guided by us) and they will eat from a lunch tray instead of a plate. Also the children will now go into assembly every Friday morning.

Expressive Art and Design and Physical Development

We will encourage the children to engage in imaginative play and role-play based on their own first-hand experiences and to develop a repertoire of actions by putting a sequence of movements together.

We will also encourage them to show respect for other children's personal space when playing amongst them, to persevere in repeating some actions/attempts when developing a new skill and collaborate in devising and sharing tasks, including those which involve accepting rules.
